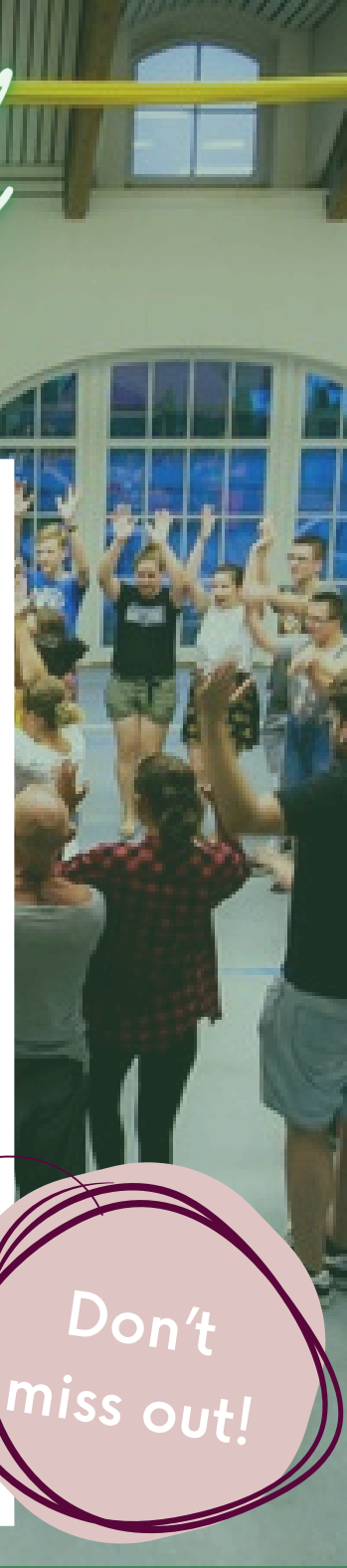
During the International Inclusive Dance Festival, young Europeans gather in a relaxed and joyful atmosphere for an unforgettable experience.

# Project Details

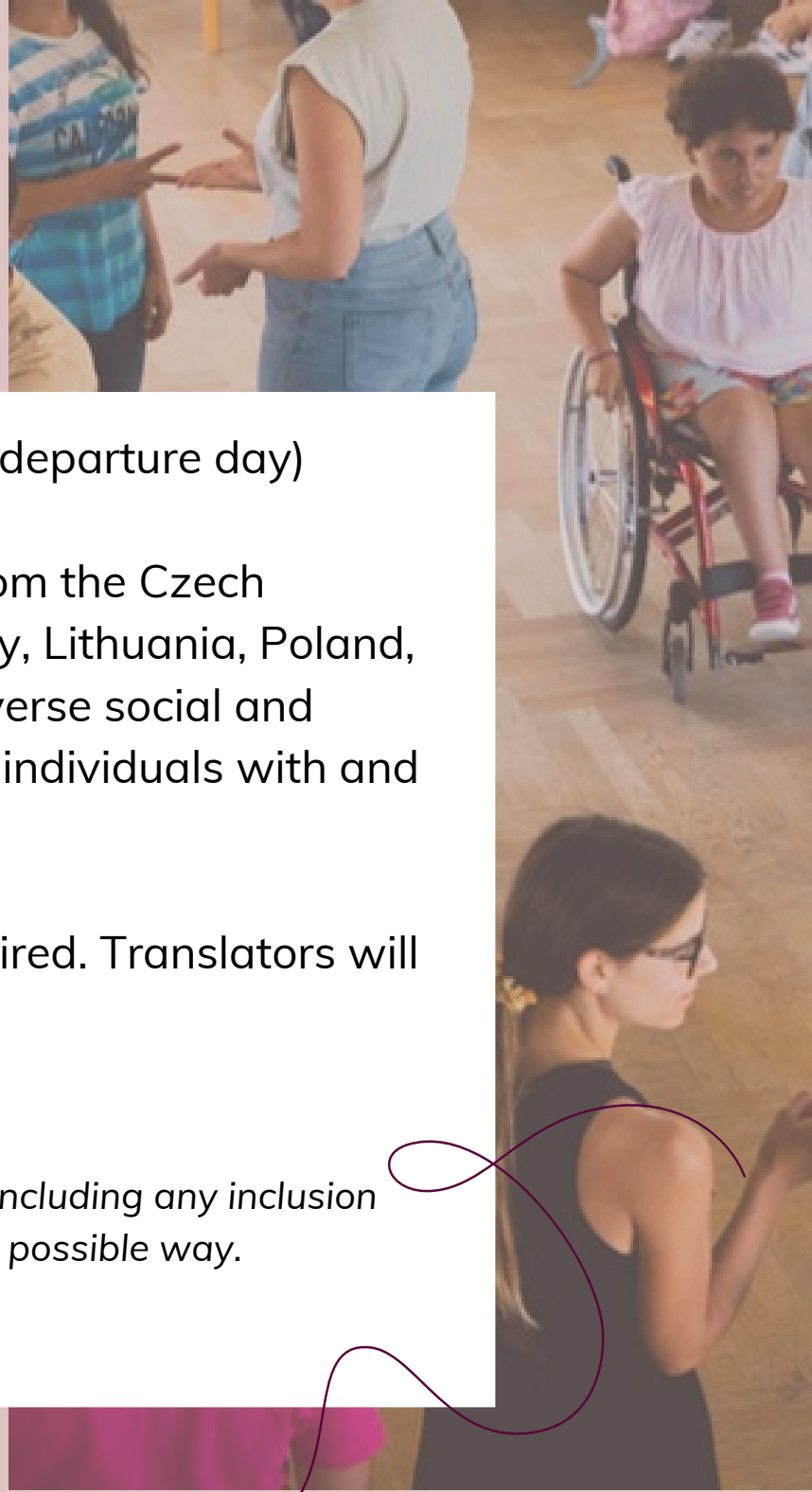
**Date:** 27.07. (arrival day) - 03.08.2026 (departure day)

**Funding:** The project is funded by the Erasmus+ program of the European Union. These funds cover the project costs.

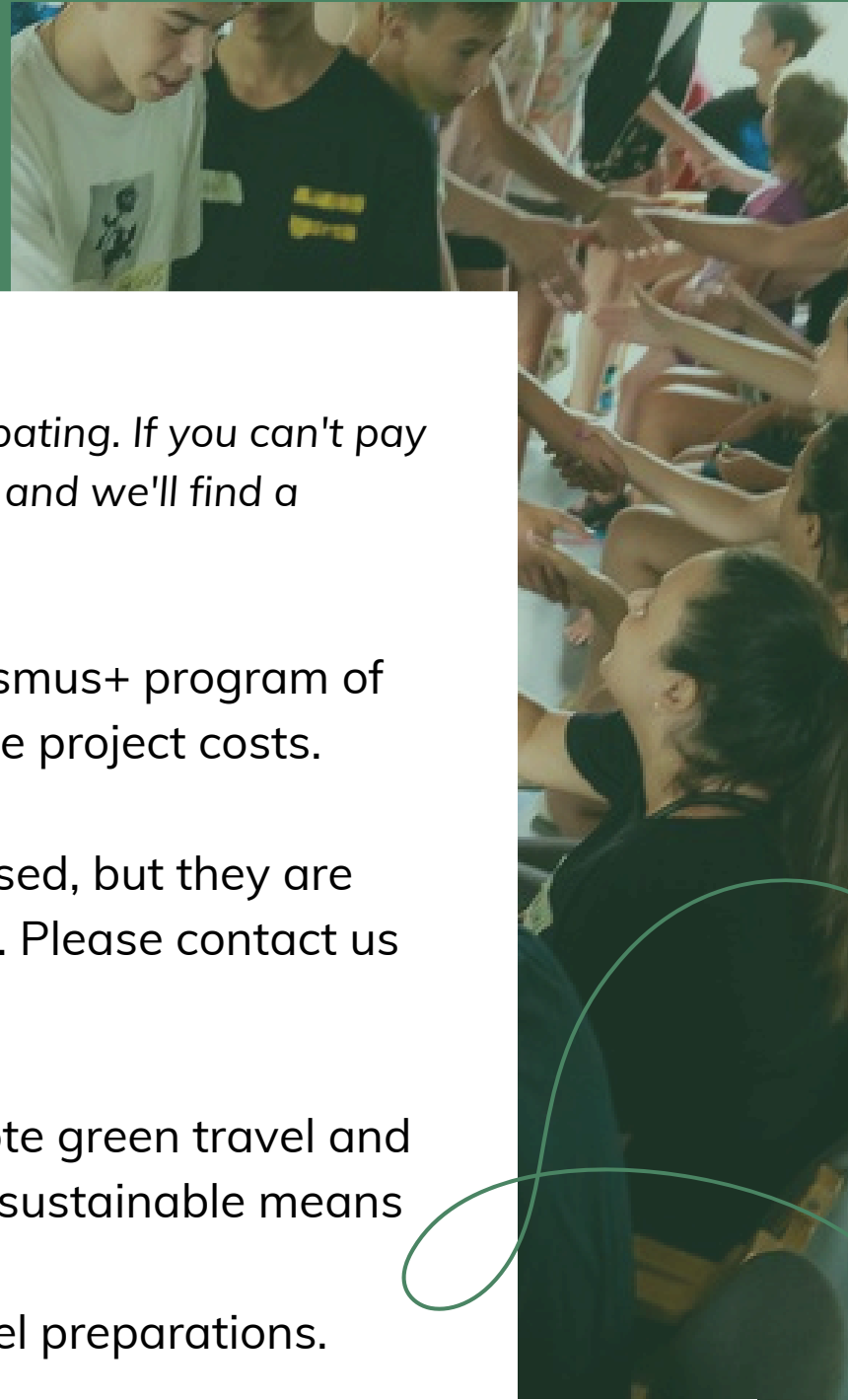
**Travel Costs:** Travel costs will be reimbursed, but they are subject to the project's funding conditions. Please contact us for more information.

# Packing Ideas

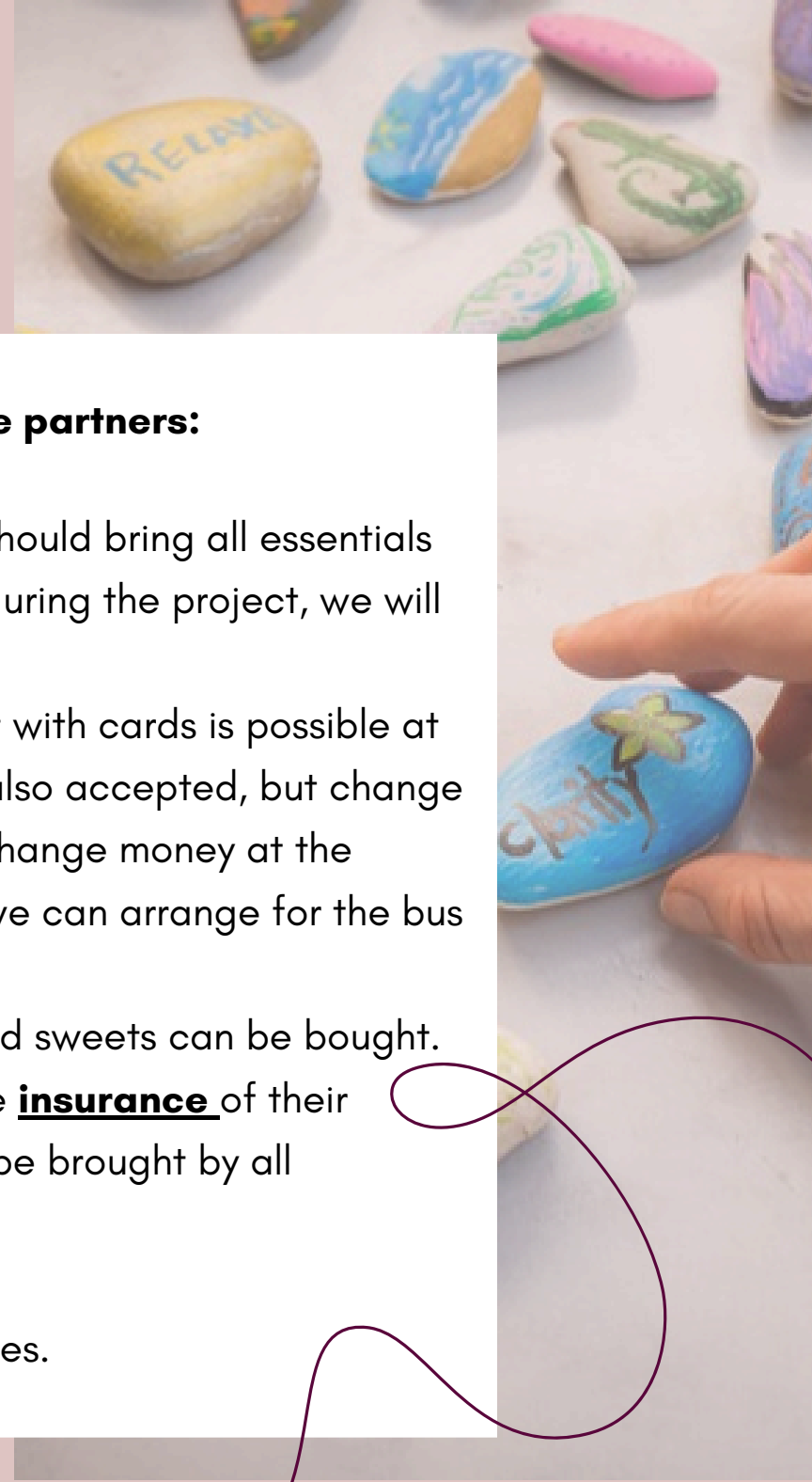
## What to pack:

Make sure to bring your everyday essentials. Here are some highlighted items that will be particularly useful:

- Clothing and shoes for dance activities
- There will be dance parties, so bring an outfit for these events.
- It gets a little humid in the evenings, so a hoodie or jacket is recommended.
- Sunscreen and mosquito spray are recommended.
- A reusable water bottle, as the tap water is drinkable, ensuring you stay hydrated
- Towel(s)
- Snacks
- There will be the occasion of T-shirt painting and coloring. Please bring light-colored T-shirts or other fabrics (bags, skirts, etc.) that you would like to decorate.



## Additional information



### Here are some important informations for the partners:

- There is no shop at the venue. Participants should bring all essentials they need. If something is urgently needed during the project, we will try to purchase it.
- The **Polish currency** is Polish Zloty. Payment with cards is possible at the venue. Payment with Euro banknotes is also accepted, but change will be given in Polish currency. You can exchange money at the airport or train stations. If traveling by bus, we can arrange for the bus to stop at an exchange place.
- There is a café at the venue where drinks and sweets can be bought.
- Partner organizations are responsible for the **insurance** of their participants. European health cards should be brought by all participants.
- A doctor will be available if needed.  
The hospital can be reached within 15 minutes.
